	North Wall: FCBC continue to manage north wall interfaces with Forth Ports and Oceaneering. Bi weekly meetings ongoing between FCBC and North Wall users.	
6.	AWP informed MLG that Exmouth Building was to be shut down end of October. To that effect the Marine Control Office will be moved to the Marine Yard. All future meetings will take place at the Main Office, Ferry Toll Road.	Note All
	AWP informed the MLG that a trial had been conducted in cooperation with Forth Ports & Forth Ports Pilots for the deployment of the Sarah-S with deck segments embarked but with a revise draft of 3.5m rather than the publicised draft of 2.86m.	
	The trial was a success with the agreement in place that if a barge was to sail with the revised draft of 3.5m then the max wind speed for deployment operations would be 15 kts not the standard 25 kts.	
	KJN stated that FTNs were overall very happy with the deck segment operations that had been conducted. There had been the odd teething problem in regard to guard boats for anchors in the channel and communication but these would be discussed at the next FCBC – FTNs meeting on the 08-10-15	
	AWP informed the MLG that all FCBC Exclusion Zone markers had been checked correct and there was no more issues.	
	DRS stated that there had been a significant reduction in breaches of the EZs by sailing vessels. AWP agreed that it seemed the message had finally gotten through and thanked DRS for his efforts to resolve this issue.	
	AWP informed the MLG that the MV Chieftain will not be being used on the project	
	AWP asked for feedback on the FCBC Deck Segment web page. All agreed it was useful and working well.
