		Following approval (09/07/14) from SNH for FCBC's design for St. Margaret's Marsh sluice gates, FCBC installed four out of five of the internal sluice gates in November 2014. Installation of the fifth internal sluice gate and three sluice gates in the sea	FCBC

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		wall will commence in December 2014 or January 2015.	
		Cutting and removal of the rank grassland lying between the seawall and the reedbed will be undertaken by FCBC, as requested by SNH, before installation of the sluice gates in the sea wall is completed, to facilitate the establishment of saltmarsh or coastal grassland once inundation commences. 	i) Site tour	EDT/FCBC conducted a site visit to St. Margaret's Marsh to show SNH the newly installed pipes for internal sluice gates. SNH and EDT observed that future excavation either side of the pipes may be beneficial to assist the flow of water between reed beds.	
	ii) Land (north):	 Installation of CMC piles at Whinny Hill/Castlandhill Road commenced. Installation of pier protection at Jameston Viaduct ongoing. Construction of Ferrytoll Road/King Malcolm Drive road and footpath realignments completed and opened 24/11/14. Construction of Ferrytoll gyratory overbridges and Ferrytoll viaduct ongoing. Construction of B981 road and footpath realignments completed and opened 24/11/14. Concrete works, steel fixing, welding, assembly and installation of launch foundations and gantry crane rail at north launch ongoing. 	
	iii) Land (south)	 Painting and welding works at southern launch steelwork assembly area ongoing. Concrete finishing works at south abutment commenced. Excavation and rock breaking at Echline. 	

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		 Utilities diversion works, road formation, drainage and kerbing works at B924 realignment ongoing. Earthworks and road formation at B800 widening ongoing. Installation of beams and deck construction works for B800 overbridge ongoing.
