FORTH REPLACEMENT CROSSING – M9 JUNCTION 1A Overnight working 29th August for 5 days

SRB Civil Engineering, on behalf of Transport Scotland, has been appointed as the main contractor to undertake the upgrade works on the M9 Junction 1a and the works are programmed to take 14 to 18 months to complete from September 2011.

We would like to advise you that we will be carrying out works on the M9 Spur and on Stirling Road overnight for the next 5 nights from Wednesday 29th August. The nature of the activities may mean that you will be aware of the works whilst in progress. The works are necessary overnight and will commence at approximately 9pm. We will endeavour to complete the works as quickly as possible.

On Thursday 30th and Friday 31st August we will be lifting into place the new section of the Newmains Road Bridge. This will involve temporary traffic disruption as traffic will be stopped in both directions for up to 30 minutes at a time between the hours of 9:30 and 3:30 and again after 7:00pm.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience that the works may cause and thank you for your continued patience whilst we construct the new junction.
