(ix)	EDT noted that both North and South Community forums had been held recently. No issues were raised on the North and traffic management was discussed on the South. This was principally for the forthcoming CEC resurfacing works on the A904 and the interface	Note

(vii)	Queensferry Hotel – It was noted that substantial renovation works were being undertaken at the Hotel and that the accommodation closest to the North Approach Viaduct works was not currently in use. FCBC would however still take noise readings once the works commence.	FCBC
(vi)	FCBC advised that two maximum noise level threshold exceedances had been recorded at the Linn Mill monitor. These were both day time exceedances.	
	<u>Monitoring</u>	
(v)	B800 road bridge demolition – FCBC will give a presentation on the proposals for these works at the April NLG meeting.	FCBC
(**)	FCBC gave a full presentation of the stages of the deck erection process. This work has to be carried out on a 24/7 basis due to the requirements for continuous welding and concreting operations. These operations will continue until all sections are in place. Works are likely to commence in May/June, working from the three towers outwards simultaneously.	. 550
(iii)	PCNV 008 Mod 16 – ESQ09 and ESQ10 bridge repair works. FCBC detailed the works to be carried out on the Dalmeny Rail Bridge (ESQ09) and the Standingstane Road Bridge (ESQ10). Due to traffic management requirements for the A90 and Network Rail possessions a lot of this work will have to be undertaken at night. The works are scheduled to commence late April and last approximately 5 months. Initial works (2months) will be on the A90 for removal of kerbing and erection of road restraint barriers. The second phase will consist of the concrete repairs to both bridges. The NLG considered the potential for disturbance due to noisier activities, noting the proximity of adjacent properties. The NLG requested that FCBC review the operations to ensure that as much work as possible is carried out at times when potential disturbance would be less. This included, for example, options for daytime working; weekend working; avoiding working consecutive nights if works caused significant disturbance for long periods. The use of temporary noise panels should also be considered for evening/night works. Focus on community engagement prior to and during the works, and monitoring during the works will be important.
