	(v)	FCBC advised that one enquiry had been received during the period. This was from a resident of Dundas. The resident reported that a bedroom window had been rattling in the morning around 8.00 to 8.15 for about a week. FCBC placed a vibration monitor adjacent to the window for a period of 5 days with attended monitoring on the second day. It was noted that no vibration inducing plant was in use at that time of the morning and that the residents had not heard any plant noise. FCBC presented the results gathered for the monitoring period and noted that the measurements were very low compared to the Contract threshold limits (Max recorded 0.28ppv against a threshold of 5ppv). These results had been presented to the resident who advised that no further disturbance had been noted.	
		Community Engagement	
		Exceedances had been recorded at the Scotstoun Monitor on a number of occasions in the period. These had all been as a result of the works being carried out immediately adjacent to the monitor. No specific actions were required by the NLG in relation to the exceedences.	
	(iv)	FCBC advised that noise monitoring had been undertaken at the properties adjacent to ESQ10 (Standingstane Road Bridge) during daytime pressure washing and repair works. Levels were shown to be well within Contract requirements. It was also noted that one of the further phases will now be undertaken during the day. It was initially expected that Network Rail restrictions would apply due to the
