

Dear Neighbour,

We are writing to provide you with an update of planned works on the Forth Replacement Crossing (FRC).

This Flyer supersedes Flyer ref 95 which was issued on 14th July 2016.

For engineering, quality and safety reasons, we are required under our contract to carry out echelon paving across the full width of the surface course on the new mainline carriageway from the B800 bridge to the south abutment in order to minimise the number of construction joints. This requires a continuous supply of asphalt from our suppliers, feeding four pavers simultaneously, and in order to guarantee this supply, permission from Transport Scotland to carry out this work on Sundays has been extended through to Sunday 30th October 2016. This work is weather dependent and it is our expectation that we will only require to work on one Sunday to complete the work required.

The hours of work will be 09:00 to 18:00 with a half hour start up from 08:30. There will be no plant movement on site prior to 09:00. The plant we will be using will include paving machines, road tippers, rollers and small loaders. Access/egress will be via the A90 as far as possible in order to minimise impact along the A904.

The programme times indicated can be influenced by many factors and may change without warning near or during the time of execution. Also, the overall duration of each element may require to be extended to achieve completion should unforseen circumstances be encountered.

We would like to take this opportunity to apologise for any inconvenience our activities may cause and also to thank you for your patience and consideration to date.
