Dear Neighbour,

We are writing to provide you with an update of planned works on the Forth Replacement Crossing (FRC).

The works to complete the surfacing of the southbound 'emergency link' tie in from the existing A90 to the new southbound (Edinburgh bound) carriageway requires traffic management (TM) on the A90 south of Echline roundabout. In order to minimise the impact of the TM on local traffic, we have sought and have been granted permission by Transport Scotland to carry out overnight/weekend working as follows:

- Friday 30th September 2016: 1900 0800 hrs Road planing and earthworks.
- Saturday 1st October 2016: 1900 0800 hrs Surfacing works.
- Sunday 2nd October 2016: 0800 0600 hrs: Surfacing and lining works.

The plant we will be using includes a road planer, excavators, paver, tippers, rollers and tower lights. Best practical means will be used to minimise disturbance. On occasion the timing of our works can change without notice as there are many variables such as weather which can affect our programme.

During this time traffic restrictions will be in place on the A90. Overnight the A90 will be reduced to a single lane southbound. Between 06:00 and 20:00 on both Saturday and Sunday this will be opened up to be at least 2 lanes for southbound traffic. At various times the alignment of the lanes may be altered to suit the on-going operations. By Monday morning all works will be completed and the A90 southbound traffic will be transferred onto the newly constructed southbound carriageway, enabling final completion of the southbound public transport link. The northbound carriageway will not be affected by these works.

We would like to take this opportunity to apologise for any disturbance these works may cause and also to thank you for your patience and consideration to date.
