We are writing to provide you with an update of planned works on the Forth Replacement Crossing (FRC), on the A90, between Admiralty and Ferrytoll.

The works will involve road surfacing, road markings and installation of temporary barriers and will be carried out working continuously from Friday 25<sup>th</sup> November 2016 commencing 20:00hrs through to Monday 28<sup>th</sup> November 2016 at 06:00hrs.

The plant involved will be a road paver, lorries, crane, site vans, generators, temporary lighting, compressors and compressed air tools.

We would like to take this opportunity to apologise, in advance, for any inconvenience our activities may cause and also to thank you for your patience and consideration to date.

The times indicated can be influenced by many factors and may change without warning near or during the time of execution. Also, the overall duration of each element may require to be extended to achieve completion should unforseen circumstances be encountered.
