Dear Neighbour,

Further to Flyer Ref F56 we are writing to provide you with notice of further planned works on the Forth Replacement Crossing (FRC).

The works described in Flyer F56 which are due to start on the night of Friday 6th June 2014 will go ahead as planned. However, some site clearance is required earlier that day. This will involve chainsaws and a pick-up truck. Work will commence at **9am on Friday 6th June 2014** and will be continuous throughout the day up to 5pm.

In addition, further works comprising topsoil strip, forming access, fencing, general earthworks and roadworks will commence on **30th June 2014** and will be continuous on the west side of the A90 **for a period of one year**. For these operations we will be using bulldozers, excavators, dump trucks, road lorries and, occasionally, vibrating rollers.

In order to mitigate noise impact throughout the process we will be deploying best practical means, mainly acoustic barriers.

The timings of the proposed works are dependent on many variables throughout the site and may change from those indicated. Also, we may encounter unforeseen ground conditions which may prolong the activities described.

Again, we would like to take this opportunity to apologise for any inconvenience our activities may cause and also to thank you for your patience and consideration to date. The works as described above are an essential part of the overall Forth Replacement Crossing project, which is necessary due to concerns over the long term viability of the existing road bridge. The new crossing will maintain a vital link in the east of Scotland road network which is key to the wider Scottish economy.
