

Forth Crossing Bridge Constructors

Dear Neighbour,

We are writing to provide you with notice of planned works on the Forth Replacement Crossing (FRC).

FCBC, the Principal Contractor working on the FRC on behalf of Transport Scotland is progressing the construction of the replacement B800 bridge and approach roads which are programmed to open to traffic later this summer.

In order to achieve completion of the approaches to the B800 bridge we will, in the first instance, divert south bound traffic over the new bridge onto the new south bound lane of the realigned B800. Meanwhile we will keep north bound traffic running on the existing north bound lane of the existing bridge to allow us to construct the new north bound lane between these two lanes – i.e. adjacent to the new south bound lane.

The attached Sketch Ref 30388-FCBC-B800-SOUTH Phase 4-TM-001 shows the proposed temporary traffic management layout.

South bound traffic exiting Dundas Castle and Dundas Home Farm will be required to turn left, go north to Ferrymuir roundabout and perform a U-turn around the roundabout to travel south. No right turn will be permitted exiting these roads for a period of approximately three weeks. Traffic from the north wishing to access Dundas Castle and Dundas Home Farm will be permitted to turn right into these entrances.

We are targeting activating this arrangement during week commencing 6<sup>th</sup> July 2015.

Once the new approaches are completed we will open the new road to traffic and complete the tie-in work at either end of the realigned road, in the off-peak period, under temporary traffic lights.

Please accept our apologies in advance if the arrangements described will cause you any inconvenience.
