Dear Neighbour,

We are writing to provide you with an update of planned works on the Forth Replacement Crossing (FRC).

This flyer is a follow up to our issue of Flyer Ref F70 and subsequent flyers which described the phasing of the works at Standing Stane Road Underpass and Dalmeny rail overbridge. We are pleased to report the successful completion of the Phase 1 and Phase 2 of the works described therein.

We are now in Phase 3, Dalmeny Bridge Repair, which involves a mixture of nightshift and dayshift works, using breakers, throughout the week, but no weekends up to and including the weekend $1^{st}/2^{nd}$ August 2015.

Thereafter we will be working nightshift including weekends for between 4 and 8 weeks on Span 3 – East Coast Mainline. This could last through to mid September 2015.

Beyond that we will be progressing Phase 4 works as per our Flyer Ref F70. This will involve installing a new bus lane and new precast concrete parapet on both the Standing Stane and Dalmeny bridges. Phase 4 works will continue with a mixture of dayshift and nightshift works through the end of 2015.

Where possible when working nightshift on these works we will endeavour to complete the noisiest works before midnight on each night and work will start at the closest point to receptors early in the shift working away from receptors as the shift progresses. We will continue to use noise screens where appropriate.

The above is our best estimate, at this stage, of dates and durations. These works are subject to various factors and the programme may require to be adjusted. We will provide further updates as appropriate.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you once again for your patience and consideration to date.
