

## Forth Crossing Bridge Constructors

Dear Neighbour,

Further to our issue of Flyer Ref F88 we confirm a change to our planned hours of work next Thursday and Friday.

Instead of carrying out surfacing works during the day we will be working at night using temporary traffic lights for traffic management.

Our works on Monday to Wednesday inclusive will be carried out at night as previously indicated. We will also deploy temporary traffic lights to control traffic for these first three nights.

In summary:-

Our working hours will be Monday to Friday (inclusive) overnight, 8pm to 6am, with a half hour start-up time in the evening starting at 7.30pm.

The detailed works programme will be as previously indicated:-

Monday 14th - plane out existing road, excavate to formation level and place capping layer.

Tuesday 15th - install gully, drainage tie-in and ducting. Install new kerbing.

Wednesday 16th - place and compact sub base and trim to level.

Thursday 17th - place two bituminous base layers.

Friday 18th - Place binder layer and surface course.

Later date (under stop/go) - road markings (very short duration)

The plant involved will include a road planer, excavators, vibrating rollers, lorries, vibrating plate compactors, road paver and road marking equipment and temporary traffic lights.

Throughout the works we will maintain emergency access at all times (to emergency vehicles and residents) and normal access, via ramps where required, for residents' vehicles from 6am to 8pm inclusive.

We will facilitate resident traffic access/egress outwith our working hours using the same temporary ramps and temporary surfaces which will provide access for the emergency services.

The programme times indicated can be influenced by many factors and may change without warning near or during the time of execution. Also, the overall duration of each element may require to be extended to achieve completion should unforseen circumstances be encountered.
