We are writing to provide you with an update of planned works on the Forth Replacement Crossing (FRC).

The work involves carrying out utility diversionary works in Hope Street, Inverkeithing .

We plan to close Hope Street to northbound traffic from Friday 25th March 2016 06:00hrs to 10th April 2016 12:00hrs inclusive to facilitate the installation of utility diversions.

The associated temporary road diversion is shown on attached Drawing No TTRO/15/136. We also enclose Fife Council Order No 2016 describing the works and the alternative route.

The plant involved will include excavators, lorries, vibrating rollers and vibrating plate compactors.

The programme times indicated can be influenced by many factors and may change without warning near or during the time of execution. Also, the overall duration of each element may require to be extended to achieve completion should unforseen circumstances be encountered.

THE FIFE COUNCIL (B981 HOPE STREET (NORTHBOUND), INVERKEITHING) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF USE) ORDER 2016

Fife Council has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 prohibiting the use by vehicular traffic of B981 Hope St (Northbound) from Ferrytoll Park & Ride to Ferryhills Rd.

The Order is to allow public utility diversion works to be carried out in safety and will be operational from 25/03/16 to 10/04/16 or until earlier completion of the works. The alternative route for through traffic will be via B980 Castlandhill Rd, Dunfermline Wynd, Hill St and B981 High St. Access for pedestrians will be maintained.
