

Dear Neighbour,

We are writing to provide you with an update of planned works on the Forth Replacement Crossing (FRC).

For engineering/quality and safety reasons, we are required under our contract to carry out echelon paving of the surface course on the new mainline carriageway from the B800 bridge to the south approach abutment in order to minimise the number of construction joints. This requires a continuous supply of asphalt from our suppliers and in order to guarantee this supply we have sought and have been granted permission by Transport Scotland to carry out this work on Sundays from 31st July through to 4th September 2016. This work is weather dependant and it is our expectation that we will only require to work on a maximum of three out of the six Sundays requested.

The hours of work will be 09:00 to 18:00 with a half hour start up from 08:30. There will be no plant movement on site prior to 09:00.

The plant we will be using will include paving machines, road tippers, rollers and small loaders.

Access/egress will be via the A90 as far as possible in order to minimise impact along the A904.

We would like to take this opportunity to apologise for any inconvenience our activities may cause and also to thank you for your patience and consideration to date.
