

Dear Neighbour,

We are writing to provide you with an update of planned overnight and daytime works on the Forth Replacement Crossing (FRC) in the Ferrymuir area.

The planned works will have a short term but significant impact on road users in the Ferrymuir area and South Queensferry in general.

The works will involve planing and resurfacing the Ferrymuir Roundabout over a period of two weekends in October 2016.

On the first weekend between 8pm on Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> October and 6am on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> October we will close the B800 south of Ferrymuir roundabout in both directions. Over the same period we will also close the B907 into and exiting South Queensferry at Ferrymuir Roundabout. Diversions will be signed for the affected traffic.

The following weekend we will partially close the same two roads between 8pm on Saturday  $22^{nd}$  October and 6am on Monday  $24^{th}$  October, with the B800 southbound from Ferrymuir remaining open to traffic at all times. The B907 traffic exiting South Queensferry at Ferrymuir will not be permitted to turn right towards the A90. Again appropriate diversions will be signed.

Access to the retail park will be available at all times throughout the duration of these works on both weekends via the B800 southbound from Echline Roundabout.

Temporary signs advising road users of these plans will be erected on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> September 2016. Motorists are advised to use an alternative route if possible.

The plant to be deployed in the execution of the works will be road planers, tipper lorries, surfacing machines, chipping machines, vibrating rollers, excavators, dumpers and compressed air tools.

We will aim to minimise any cutting or breaking at night time.

We would like to convey our apologies to the road users and residents who have been and will be inconvenienced by our works in the Ferrymuir area.

The times indicated can be influenced by many factors and may change without warning near or during the time of execution. Also, the overall duration of each element may require to be extended to achieve completion. Should unforseen circumstances be encountered, a third weekend may be required to complete the works.
