Dear Neighbour,

FCBC, the contractor working on the Forth Replacement Crossing principal contract, hereby writes to inform you that Scottish Water Diversionary Works are due to be carried out overnight on Tuesday 20th November 2012 in the vicinity of the junction of the U221 and the A904.THIS SUPERCEDES THE ARRANGEMENT STATED ON FLYER REF F22 ISSUED ON FRIDAY 9TH NOVEMBER 2012.

The works to be executed include cutting and capping the existing water main which runs up the U221. The cap is to be placed at the junction with the A904. The works will not involve interrupting the water supply.

We have decided the safest time to carry out the work is at night.

The timing of the works shall be from 20:00 hours on the evening of Tuesday 20th November 2012 through to 06:00 hours on the morning of Wednesday 21st November 2012 and the U221 shall be closed, in the vicinity of the work, over this period.

The plant involved shall include an excavator, road wagon, pick-up truck, vans, pipecutting equipment and small tools powered by both generator and compressed air where required.

The works shall be carried out by Farrans Limited on behalf of Scottish Water. If you have any questions about Scottish Water, please contact their Customer Helpline on 0845 601 8855 quoting Forth Replacement Crossing/Farrans.

The works as described above are an essential part of the overall Forth Replacement Crossing project, which is necessary due to concerns over the long term viability of the existing road bridge. The new crossing will maintain a vital link in the east of Scotland road network which is key to the wider Scottish economy.

We would like to take this opportunity to apologise, in advance, for any inconvenience our activities may cause and also to thank you for your patience and consideration to date.
