	N1: Deck pours ongoing towards N1 from north approach. Ana S in position supporting AV North & CSB lifts to deck level for closure to SN12. North east quadrant remaining following cofferdam removal. Land access still in place.			
	NT: Deck segments installed to SN12 and FN12. 7 segments short of CLN. Works ongoing for SN12-12 closure & tie down. Erection Traveller being dismantled and returning ashore via E1704 Segment welding operations ongoing			
	CT: Deck segments installed to CN14 & CS14. 5 segments to CLN & CLS Strand installation ongoing along with segment welding and stitch pours.			
	ST: Deck segments installed to FS13 & SS14. Complex lift operations of SS14 & 13 completed to Pier S1. 6 segments remaining to CLN.			
	 S1: Pier pours complete. Pier now under CSB. Tie down operations for SS14 and closure steelwork between SS13 & 14 ongoing. Isabella crane barge on location in support. Remaining sections of S1 temporary caisson being removed this week in preparation for Segment SS15. 			
	S2: Pier pours complete. Preparations ongoing for receiving deck segments and temporary works in support. NP421 crane barge currently supporting S2-4 on east and west sides.			

	Lower waler beams cut out prior to cofferdam removal. Cofferdam removal due to commence in coming weeks. AV South deck pours ongoing from shore working in similar fashion to AV North.		
	NW: 74/110 load outs completed. Constant liaison ongoing with Fort Ports & Oceaneering for berth use. Bi-weekly meetings ongoing to review programme and potential conflicts. Cruise ship season up and running, ladder repairs completed and fenders serviced for cruise season.

6.	 <u>AOB</u> CCN informed the MLG that the construction accident at NT was still under investigation by the H&S and Police The recovery of the casualty went very smoothly with the coastguard rendering assistance with casualties and witnesses at Hawes Pier. The whole incident proved that contingency planning worked well & that support at Hawes Pier was of a high standard. CCN also noted for everyone to brief their departments that security access at N1 and NT was now a major concern as they are now joined and that you can walk from shore to the edge of NT deck sections. All departments should remain vigilant BMO raised the issue of the recent damaged to the ballast tanks of the Sarah-S. AWP informed the MLG that damage had been suffered to the Sarah-S during Ballasting Operations. Some of her ballast tanks had been damaged and that she was now berthed in Babcocks for inspection and repair assessment. 		All
