	North Tower – final excavation to rock underway. Central Tower – Cofferdam complete; final sealing this week. South Tower – Jet grouting on-going – completes this week. S1 Viaduct - Caisson excavation on-going. S4 Viaduct - cofferdam stabilising and cleaning. S5 Viaduct - cofferdam stabilising and cleaning.		Note

	KCK updated the meeting on the current 6 monthly look ahead programme. The main areas of effort over the forthcoming period will see the completion of the excavation within the main caissons and the placing of foundation concrete as well as the commencement of the Central Tower.		Note

	KCK advised that there was a growing concern over the presence of sea – kayaks and other canoes around the construction zones; the recent calm weather has seen a few around the site particularly on the south side. There are concerns that this group may not be aware of the extant NTM's and other recent chart information changes. In light of this wider information dissemination is required.		Note
