# The A96 Trunk Road (Dyce Drive Roundabout to Craibstone) Detrunking Order 200

Coming into force	200

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5(2) and (6) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 5(2) of that Act, they are satisfied as to expediency.

They have complied with the requirements of Part I of Schedule 1(b) to that Act.

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A96 Trunk Road (Dyce Drive Roundabout to Craibstone) Detrunking Order 200 and shall come into force on [ ].

#### Road ceasing to be a trunk road

- **2.**—(1) On 1st April next after the date on which the new special roads and trunk roads are all open—
  - (a) for use as special roads; or
  - (b) (in the case of the new lengths of trunk road which are not a special road), for the purposes of through traffic,
    - the length of road along the route described in the Schedule shall cease to be a trunk road and Aberdeen City Council(c) shall become the roads authority for that length of road and shall enter that length of road in their list of public roads.
- (2) In paragraph (1) "the new special roads and trunk roads" means the new special roads to be provided and the roads becoming trunk roads, as the case may be, by virtue of—
  - (a) the A90 (Aberdeen Western Peripheral Route) Special Road Scheme 200 (d);

## **SCHEDULE**

Article 2

## ROAD CEASING TO BE A TRUNK ROAD

## INTERPRETATION

#### In this Schedule-

"the existing A96 Trunk Road" means the existing A96 Aberdeen – Inverness Trunk Road between the east, south-easternmost edge of the existing Dyce Drive roundabout, Aberdeen and Craibstone, Aberdeen including all lay-bys and bus lay-bys;

"the plan" means the plan numbered RYC/G109/13/0723 and entitled "The A96 Trunk Road (Dyce Drive Roundabout to Craibstone) Detrunking Order 200", signed with reference to this Order and deposited at the offices of Transport Scotland, Buchanan House, 58 Port Dundas Road, Glasgow, G4 0HF; and

"point 1" means the south-west corner of the building known as Chapel Works, Bucksburn, Aberdeen, AB21 9TL shown marked "point 1" on the plan.

#### LENGTH OF ROAD CEASING TO BE A TRUNK ROAD

That length of the existing A96 Trunk Road from a point 1.67 kilometres or thereby east, south-east of point 1 in a generally west, north-westerly direction for a distance of 790 metres or thereby including the existing Dyce Drive roundabout to a point 970 metres or thereby east, south-east of point 1 as shown by black and white hatching between the points marked "point A" and "point B" on the plan.
