4.1	Progress update and 3 month look ahead EB provided presentation of works progress with project overview and look ahead – including: - Pavement works (i.e. resurfacing M9 and Spur) to be complete early December - Landscaping will continue to end January/early February - Once paving works are complete, will finalise loop - Safety barrier on M9 to complete second week in December - M9 overbridge and existing bridge are near complete - Overton Road re-opened October – works will complete in two weeks, following completion of Overton Bridge - New Mains Bridge – drainage works are complete, some barrier and snagging works remain - Fencing – substantially complete, introduced as sections complete, 20 meters of noise barrier to complete this week - EB confirmed letter updates are being issued regularly, particularly to residents at Buie Rigg and Kirklands Park Grove. - SRB is continuing to engage with the local primary school, including helping paint school playground games and providing funding for an environmental project. - Works are on schedule and will be largely complete before Christmas with contractor aiming to be off site by March 2013.
