SRB Civil Engineering,on behalf of Transport Scotland,has been appointed as the main contractor to undertake the upgrade works on the M9 Junction 1a.

We have recently commenced works around NewmainsBridge over Stirling Road and this has required some intensive sheet piling activities to be carried out.
