THE SCOTTISH ROAD WORKS REGISTER (PRESCRIBED FEES) REGULATIONS 2017

The above instrument is being made in exercise of powers conferred by section 112A(4) of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (c.22). The purpose of the Regulations is to set the level of a fee payable by roads authorities and statutory undertakers for access to the Scottish Road Works Register (the Register).

The prescribed fee must be set at a level which will meet the annual cost of running the Register. The projected running cost for 2017/18 is £954,000 and for 2018/19 is £1,110,000.

We would like your views, **supported by evidence where possible**, on whether the fees should be changed as proposed for 2017/18 and 2018/19 or whether whether some alternative arrangement should be put in place.
