# The A78 Trunk Road (Gallowgate Street, Largs) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 2014

Made - - - - -Coming into force - - 16th October 2014 1st November 2014

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 124(1)(d), of and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 1(1) of that Act, they consider it expedient to make this Order to facilitate the passage on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule of vehicular traffic and to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the lengths of road so specified or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

They have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Order (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b).

#### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A78 Trunk Road (Gallowgate Street, Largs) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 2014 and comes into force on 1st November 2014.

#### Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. Subject to Articles 5 to 7, no person shall use, or cause or permit the use of any vehicle to wait, at any time, in the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule.

**3.** Subject to Articles 5 and 7 no person shall use, or cause or permit the use of any vehicle to wait between the hours of 10am to 7pm in the length of road specified in Part 2 of the Schedule;

- (a) for a period of more than one hour; or
- (b) if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the last period of waiting of the vehicle in that length of road.

4. Subject to Articles 5 and 7 no person shall use, or cause or permit the use of a vehicle to wait, at any time, for the purpose of loading or unloading in the length of road specified in Part 2 of the Schedule.

#### Permission or direction of Police Constable

5. Nothing in Articles 2, 3 and 4 of this Order applies to anything done with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform.

#### **Exemption for certain purposes**

6.—(1) Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall prevent any goods vehicle to wait for as long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule.

(2) For the purposes of this Order, "goods vehicle" means any vehicle or trailer constructed or adapted for use for the carriage or haulage of goods or burden of any description.

7. Nothing in Articles 2 to 4 of this Order shall apply—

- (a) for as long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for any of the purposes hereinafter described on any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the said lengths of road specified in the Schedule or the laying, erection, alteration or repair on or near any of the lengths of road so specified, of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any electronic communications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984(a);
- (b) to prevent a vehicle being used in connection with funeral operations;
- (c) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his or her control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
- (d) if the vehicle is being used for the purpose of collecting postal packets or delivering postal packets as defined in section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000(**b**);
- (e) to vehicles being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes.

**8.** Omit paragraph (4) (Gallowgate Street (A78 Trunk Road) Largs) of Schedule 4a to the North Ayrshire Council (Largs) (Traffic Management) Order 2010(c), (waiting limited to 1 Hour, 10am to 7pm – Trunk Roads).

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# THE NORTH AYRSHIRE COUNCIL (LARGS) (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2010

The North Ayrshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order.

#### Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as the "The North Ayrshire Council (Largs) (Traffic Management) Order 2010" and shall come into operation on 12<sup>th</sup> April 2010.

#### Interpretation

- (a) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to an Act of Parllament.
  - (b) The Council is satisfied that for facilitating the passage of vehicular traffic on the road it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 should not apply to this Order.
  - (c) In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"council" means North Ayrshire Council;

"disabled person's badge" and "relevant position" have the meanings given in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2002;

"emergency services vehicle" means a vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade, Ambulance Services or Civil Defence Organisation purposes;

"goods vehicle" means a vehicle constructed or adapted for the use of conveyance of goods or burden of any description but not including a dual-purpose vehicle;

"licensed private hire car" means a private hire car licensed under Section 10 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, clearly marked as such and driven by a person holding a valid private hire car driver's licence or taxi driver's licence issued in accordance with Section 13 of the aforementioned Act;

"local authority" means body charged with the administration of local Government;

"private hire car" has the same meaning as in Section 23 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982;

"taxi" has the same meaning as in Section 23(1) of the Clvic Government (Scotland) Act 1982; "universal service provider" has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000;

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power;

"driver" in relation to a vehicle in a loading bay area for the purpose of loading and unloading, means a person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the loading bay area;

"loading bay area" means the part of the road authorised by this Order to be used as a loading and unloading only area and indicated by sign diagram 660.4 as defined in Schedule 2 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994;

"coach" means a vehicle constructed or adapted to carry 12 or more passengers (exclusive of the driver) but not including any vehicle engaged in operation on a registered service or school/work services;

"trunk roads authority" means the national transport agency of the Scottish Government responsible for the management and maintenance of the trunk road network.

## No waiting and no loading at any time

3 Save as provided in Article 7 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any length of road specified in Schedules 1a and 1b to this Order.

#### No waiting at any time

4 Save as provided in Articles 7, 8 and 15 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any length of road specified in Schedules 2a and 2b to this Order.

## No waiting within stated times

5 Save as provided in Articles 7, 9 and 15A of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 10 am to 7 pm in any length of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.

# Limited waiting within stated times

- 6. Save as provided in Articles 7, 9 and 15A of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 10 am to 7 pm, in any length of road specified in Schedules 4a and 4b to this Order: -
  - (i) for a longer period than 1 hour; or
  - (ii) if a period of less than 1 hour has elapsed since the last period of waiting of the vehicle in the same length of road.

## Exemptions to Articles 3 to 6

- 7. Nothing in Articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 of this Order shall:-
  - (i) prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any length of road referred to in that Article:-
    - (a) for as long as may be necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or to load thereon or unload therefrom his/her personal luggage;
    - (b) If the vehicle is an emergency services vehicle;
    - (c) If the vehicle is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the driver's control or which has to be stopped in order to avoid injury or damage to persons or property;
    - (d) if the vehicle is a marked vehicle which, whilst used by a universal service provider in the course of the provision of a universal postal service, is stationary only for so long as may be reasonably necessary for postal packets to be delivered or collected;
    - (e) if the vehicle is parked in connection with demolition works, removals from premises or funeral purposes;
  - (ii) apply to a licensed taxi waiting in a taxi stance during any period for which that stance has been designated by the Council under the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982.

## Exemption to Allow Vehicles to Load

- 8. (i) Save as provided in part (ii) of this Article nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall prevent any person, from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or loading or unloading the vehicle;
  - (ii) provided that:-

(a) no such vehicle shall wait for a longer period than 30 minutes in the same place;

(b) no such vehicle shall wait for a longer period than 10 minutes in the same place without goods being loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle.

# Exemption to Allow Vehicles to Load

9. (i)

Save as provided in part (ii) of this Article nothing In Articles 5 and 6 of this Order shall prevent any person, from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait between the hours of 10 am to 7 pm in the lengths of road referred to in those Articles for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or loading or unloading the vehicle;

(ii) provided that:-

(a) no such vehicle shall wait for a longer period than 30 minutes in the same place:

(b) no such vehicle shall wait for a longer period than 10 minutes in the same place without goods being loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle.

#### Use of Loading Bay Areas

- 10. (i) The parts of the road specified in Schedules 5a and 5b to this Order are authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as loading bay areas, for all classes of vehicle, in such positions as specified in relation to that part of the road in the said Schedules for the purposes of loading and unloading only.
  - (ii) Nothing in paragraph (i) of this Article shall restrict the power of the Council or Trunk Roads Authority to close any loading bay area.
  - (iii) Nothing in paragraph (i) of this Article shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to wait in the loading bay area specified in that paragraph if the vehicle is being used:-

a) In the service of the local authority or trunk roads authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

b) In the service of the Police Authority; Fire Brigade or Ambulance Service in case of emergency; or

In connection with any building operation, or demolition, the removal of any C) obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Code contained in the Telecommunications Act 1984, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.

The driver of any vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a loading bay area for longer than is necessary to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded from a vehicle.

11.

12. The driver of a vehicle shall not wait in a loading bay area:-

a) So as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the road, or the use of the road by other persons, or so as to be a nuisance;

b) When for preventing obstruction of the loading bay area on a particular day or for a particular purpose the Council or Trunk Roads Authority has closed that loading bay area and exhibited notice of such closing in or near the loading bay area.

13. The driver of a motor vehicle using a loading bay area shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in a position in the loading bay area and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle or to depart from the loading bay.

14. No person shall use a vehicle while it is in the loading bay area, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the loading bay area, or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services.

## Exemption for Disabled Badge Holders

- 15. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position to walt in any length of road referred to in that Article provided that no vehicle shall wait for a longer period than 3 hours.
- 15A. Nothing in Articles 5 and 6 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position to wait between the hours of 10 am to 7 pm in any length of road referred to in that Article provided that no vehicle shall wait for a longer period than 3 hours.

# One Way Operation

16. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any length of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 6 to this Order otherwise than in the directions specified opposite in Column 2 of the said Schedule.

# Prohibition of driving at any time except disabled person's badge holders at any time and for loading between 7pm and 10am

17. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle at any time on any length of road specified in Schedule 7 to this Order with the exception of: (i) vehicles which are driven by or carrying a disabled person and which display in the relevant position a disabled persons badge at any time and (ii) vehicles with the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise between the hours of 7pm and 10am.

#### Prohibition of Driving Except for Taxis

18. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle other than those designated as a taxl on any length of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 8 to this Order otherwise than in the direction specified opposite in Column 2 of the said Schedule.

# Prohibition of Right Turn

29. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on any road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 9 to this Order so as to make a right hand turn into the road specified opposite in Column 2 of the said Schedule.

# Disabled person's vehicle parking places

- 20. (a) Each parking place designated in Schedules 10a and 10b to this Order may be used without payment, subject to the provisions of this Order, for the leaving, for the maximum of 3 hours, of a vehicle which is driven by or carrying a disabled person and which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge.
  - (b) Each parking place designated in Schedule 10a and 10b to this Order shall be indicated, in such a manner as the Council or Trunk Roads Authority shall determine, by signs or by carriageway markings.

# Designated Coach Pick Up and Drop Off Bay

- 21. (i) The part of the road specified in Schedule 11 to this Order is authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a pick up and drop off bay for coaches in such positions and for a maximum of 15 minutes as specified in relation to that part of the road in the said Schedule for the purposes of picking up or dropping off of passengers only.
  - (II) Nothing in paragraph (i) of this Article shall restrict the power of the Council to close any coach pick up and drop off bay.
  - (iii) Nothing in paragraph (i) of this Article shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to wait in the designated coach pick up and drop off bay specified in that paragraph if the vehicle is being used:-

a) In the service of the local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

b) In the service of the Police Authority; Fire Brigade or Ambulance Service in case of emergency; or

(c) In connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road.

# Orders to be amended

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22. The Existing Orders specified in Schedule 12 to this Order are hereby amended as indicated.

# Orders to be revoked

23. The Existing Orders specified in Schedule 13 to this Order are hereby revoked.




