**The A96 Trunk Road (Forres Bypass) (40mph Speed Limit)
Order 2014**

Made - - - - *14th August 2014*

Coming into force - - *25th August 2014*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 84(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Scottish Ministers have given public notice of their intention to make the following Order, and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987^(b).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A96 Trunk Road (Forres Bypass) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2014 and comes into force on 25th August 2014.

Speed restriction

2. No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Revocation

3. The Aberdeen-Inverness Trunk Road (A96) (Forres Bypass) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1989^(c) is revoked.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A96 Aberdeen - Inverness Trunk Road at Forres, from a point 57 metres or thereby west of its junction with the extended centreline of Greshop Road, Forres, in a north easterly direction to a point 231 metres or thereby east of its junction with the extended centreline of Mosset Road, Forres, a distance of 1541 metres or thereby.
