ROAD TRAFFIC

The A78 Trunk Road (Greenock) (30mph Speed Limit and Part-Time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2015

Made - - - - - Coming into force - -

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 84(2)(b) of that Act, they have given public notice of their intention to make this Order and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(c).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A78 Trunk Road (Greenock) (30mph Speed Limit and Part-Time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2015 and comes into force on

Speed restrictions

- 2. No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding:—
 - (a) 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order;or
 - (b) 20 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order when that particular speed limit is identified as applying to that length of road by means of the appropriate traffic sign prescribed in diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(d).

Revocation

3. The A78 Trunk Road Greenock Schools (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2006(e) is revoked.

SCHEDULE SPECIFIED LENGTHS OF ROAD

Article 2

PART 1

1. That length of the A78 Greenock to Prestwick Trunk Road at Greenock from a point 222 metres or thereby west of the centre line of its junction with Flatterton Road to the northeast kerbline of the splitter island at the A8 Bullring Roundabout, a distance of 4.82 kilometres or thereby.

PART 2

2. That length of the A78 Greenock to Prestwick Trunk Road at Greenock from a point 158 metres or thereby west of the centre line of its junction with Gateside Avenue to a point 9 metres or thereby south of the centre line of its junction with the westbound approach of Old Inverkip Road, a distance of 372 metres or thereby.

THE A78 TRUNK ROAD (GREENOCK) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT AND PART-TIME 20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2015

THE SCOTTISH MINISTERS give notice that they propose to make the above Order under sections 84(1)(a) and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 30mph and a part time 20mph speed limit on the following lengths of the A78 Trunk Road through Greenock:-

30mph Speed Limit

That length of the A78 Greenock to Prestwick Trunk Road at Greenock from a point 222 metres or thereby west of the centre line of its junction with Flatterton Road to the northeast kerbline of the splitter island at the A8 Bullring Roundabout, a distance of 4.82 kilometres or thereby.

Part-time 20mph Speed Limit

That length of the A78 Greenock to Prestwick Trunk Road at Greenock from a point 158 metres or thereby west of the centre line of its junction with Gateside Avenue to a point 9 metres or thereby south of the centre line of its junction with the westbound approach of Old Inverkip Road, a distance of 372 metres or thereby.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the Order which, together with a plan showing the length of road involved, a copy of the Order being revoked and a statement of the Scottish Ministers' reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined free of charge during normal business hours from 1st May 2015 until 2nd June 2015 at Transport Scotland, Buchanan House, 58 Port Dundas Road, Glasgow, G4 0HF; and Inverclyde Council, Municipal Buildings, Greenock, PA15 1LY.



ROAD TRAFFIC

The A78 Trunk Road Greenock Schools (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2006

Made Coming into force 29th August 2006 11th September 2006

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) and (c) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A78 Trunk Road Greenock Schools (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2006 and shall come into force on 11th September 2006.

Restriction of Speed

- 2. (1) No person shall drive any motor vehicle on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 20mph when such speed limit applies to that length of road in accordance with paragraph (2).
- (2) A 20mph speed limit applies to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order when a 20mph speed limit is indicated by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(c).

That length of the A78 Greenock Prestwick Trunk Road at Greenock from a point 158 metres or thereby west of the centre line of the junction with Gateside Avenue to a point 9 metres or thereby south of the centre line of the junction with the westbound approach of Old Inverkip Road, a distance of 372 metres or thereby.
