**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A87 Trunk Road (Cluanie Inn to Kintail Lodge) (50 mph  
Speed Limit) Order 2015**

*Made* - - - -

*Coming into force* - -

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 84(2)(b) of that Act, they have given public notice of their intention to make this Order, and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(c).

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the A87 Trunk Road (Cluanie Inn to Kintail Lodge) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2015 and comes into force on [ ]

**Speed restriction**

2. No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c.27) (inserted by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (c.22), ("the 1991 Act"), Schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by S.I. 2001/1400) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54) (as amended by S.I. 2001/1400). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by S.I. 1999/1750.

### **Exemption**

**3.** No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011<sup>(a)</sup> when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

Article 2

### SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A87 Invergarry – Kyle of Lochalsh – Borve – Uig Trunk Road from a point (at Ordnance Map coordinates 207798, 811775) 150 metres or thereby east of the point where it meets the extended eastern gable of Cluanie Inn, generally westwards, to a point (at Ordnance Map coordinates 194147, 819982), 1.482 kilometres or thereby northwest then northeast of the extended centreline of the junction with the C1223 Shiel bridge - Corran road, a distance of 20.06 kilometres or thereby.

## PRESS NOTICE

### THE A87 TRUNK ROAD (CLUANIE INN TO KINTAIL LODGE) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2015

THE SCOTTISH MINISTERS give notice that they propose to make the above Order under section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

This will have the effect of imposing a 50 mph speed limit on that length of the A87 Invergarry – Kyle of Lochalsh – Borve – Uig Trunk Road from a point (at Ordnance Map coordinates 207798, 811775) 150 metres or thereby east of the point where it meets the extended eastern gable of Cluanie Inn, generally westwards, to a point (at Ordnance Map coordinates 194147, 819982), 1.482 kilometres or thereby northwest then northeast of the extended centreline of the junction with the C1223 Shiel bridge - Corran road, a distance of 20.06 kilometres or thereby.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the Order which, together with a plan showing the length of road involved, and a statement of the Scottish Ministers' reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined free of charge during normal business hours from 29th January 2015 until 26th February 2015 at Transport Scotland, Buchanan House, 58 Port Dundas Road, Glasgow, G4 0HF; Dornie Post Office, 3 Francis Street, Kyle, Highland, IV40 8EJ; and Cluanie Inn, Skye & Lochalsh, Glenmoriston, Inverness, IV63 7YW.

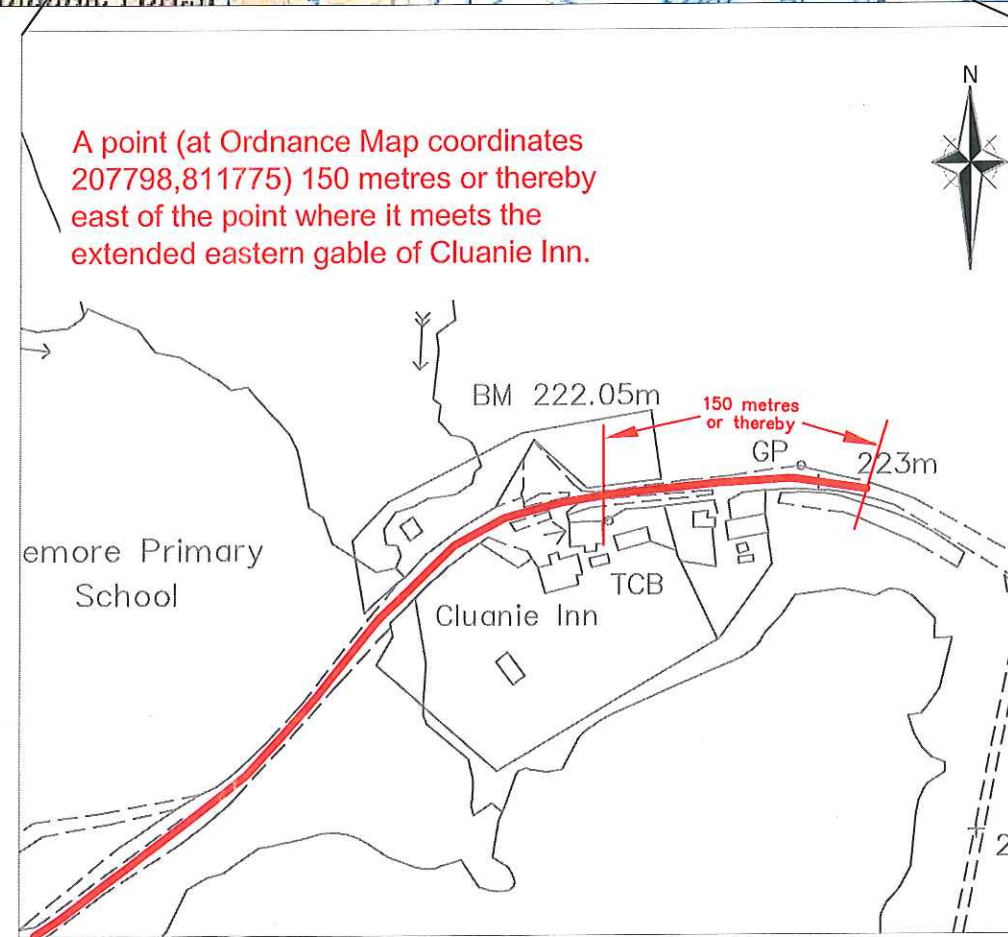
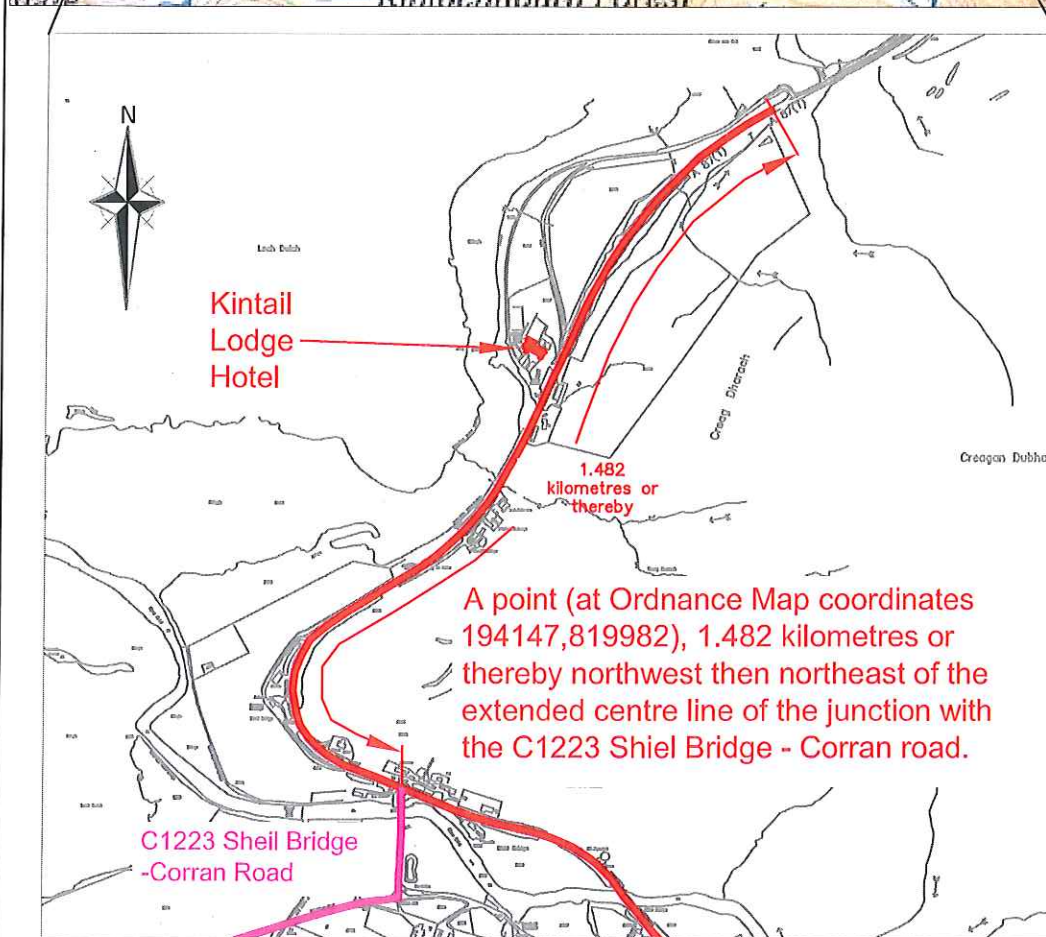
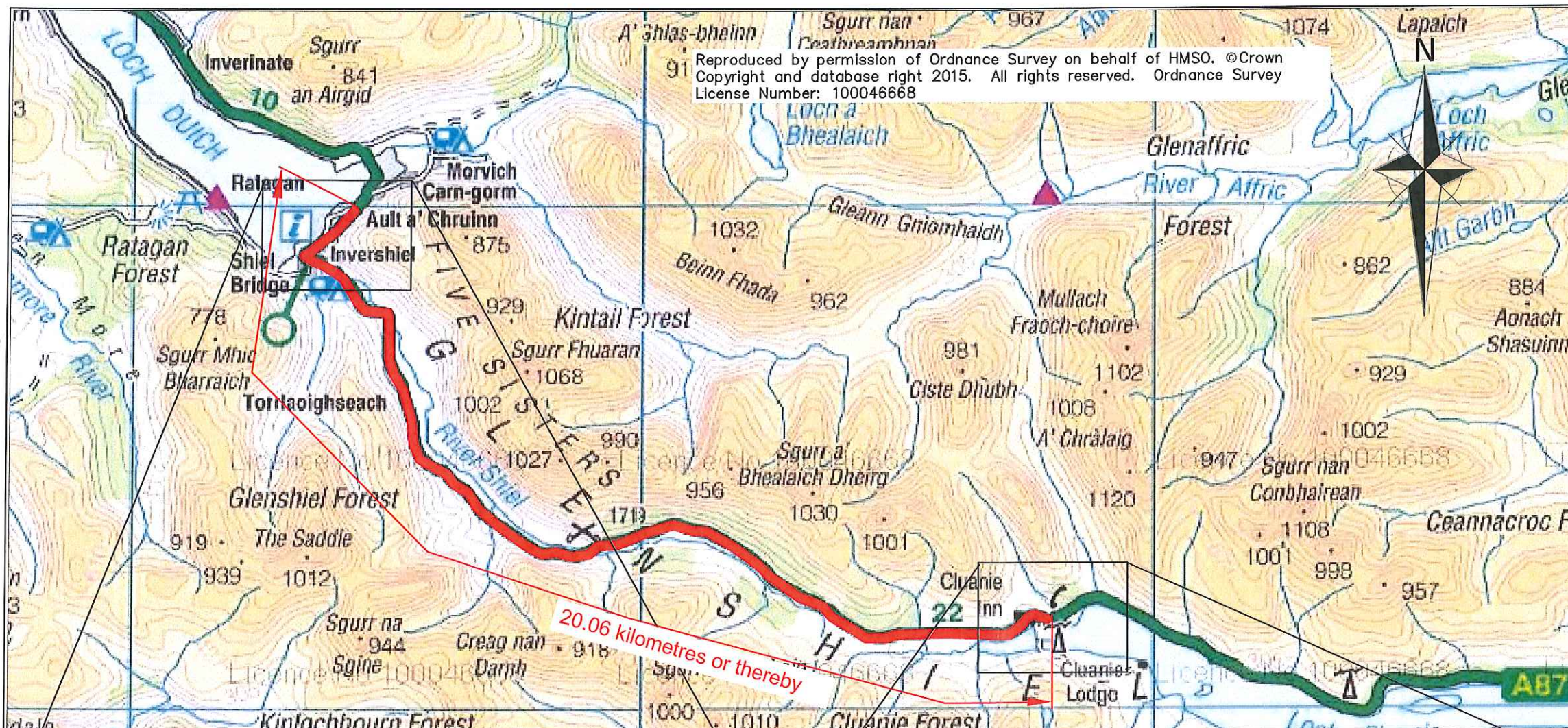

## Statement of The Scottish Ministers' Reasons for Applying a Maximum Speed Limit of 50mph on the Section of the A87 between Cluanie Inn and Kintail Lodge

Following completion of the Speed Limit Review, Scottish Ministers are satisfied that a 50mph Speed Limit be imposed on the A87 Trunk Road from Cluanie Inn to Kintail Lodge to improve road safety. The 50mph speed limit is consistent with other similar routes and is appropriate to the function and nature of the road.
