The M9/A9 Trunk Road (Field Accesses North of the B934 Junction, Perthshire)
(Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2008

Made Coming into force

5th December 2008 19th December 2008

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1(1) as read with sections 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the M9/A9 Trunk Road (Field Accesses North of the B934 Junction, Perthshire) (Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2008 and shall come into force on 19th December 2008.

Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. Subject to Article 3 of this Order, no person shall use, or cause or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order so as to make any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order provided that the said prohibition shall apply only to the part or parts of the said length of road by means of traffic signs as prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(c).

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scotlish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Permission or Direction of Police Constable

3. No provision of this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

- 1. That length of the M9/A9 Edinburgh Stirling Thurso Trunk Road in Perthshire from a point 473 metres or thereby north of its junction with the B934 Upper Cairnie Road to a point 456 metres or thereby north of its junction with the B934 Upper Cairnie Road, a distance of 17 metres or thereby.
- 2. That length of the M9/A9 Edinburgh Stirling Thurso Trunk Road in Perthshire from a point 664 metres or thereby north of its junction with the B934 Upper Cairnie Road to a point 651 metres or thereby north of its junction with the B934 Upper Cairnie Road, a distance of 13 metres or thereby.

PART 2

- All right turns from the northbound carriageway of the M9/A9 Edinburgh Stirling Thurso Trunk Road into the field access adjacent to the southbound carriageway of the M9/A9 Edinburgh Stirling Thurso Trunk Road 464 metres or thereby north of the B934 Junction.
- 2. All right turns from the field access adjacent to the southbound carriageway of the M9/A9 Edinburgh Stirling Thurso Trunk Road 464 metres or thereby north of the B934 Junction onto the northbound carriageway of the M9/A9 Edinburgh Stirling Thurso Trunk Road.
- 3. All right turns from the northbound carriageway of the M9/A9 Edinburgh Stirling Thurso Trunk Road into the field access adjacent to the southbound carriageway of the M9/A9 Edinburgh Stirling Thurso Trunk Road 658 metres or thereby north of the B943 Junction.
- 4. All right turns from the field access adjacent to the southbound carriageway of the M9/A9 Edinburgh Stirling Thurso Trunk Road 658 metres or thereby north of the B934 Junction onto the northbound carriageway of the M9/A9 Edinburgh Stirling Thurso Trunk Road.

THE SCOTTISH MINISTERS hereby give notice that on 5th December 2008, they made the above Order under section 1(1) as read with sections 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order is as described in Notice 1501/243 in the Edinburgh Gazette on 3rd November 2006 No.3871 and the Daily Record dated 3rd November 2006. The Order comes into force on 19th December 2008.
