The A887 Trunk Road (Torgoyle) (50mph Speed Limit) Order

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 84(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Scottish Ministers have given public notice of their intention to make the following Order, and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A887 Trunk Road (Torgoyle) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2011 1 and comes into force on

Speed restriction

2. No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c.27) (inserted by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (c.22), Schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by S.I. 2001/1400) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by S.I. 1999/1750.

Exemption

3. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

THE A887 TRUNK ROAD (TORGOYLE) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2011

THE SCOTTISH MINISTERS hereby give notice that they propose to make the above Order under section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will have the effect of imposing a 50 mph speed limit on that length of the A887 Invermoriston – Moriston Trunk Road from a point 41 metres or thereby north east of the extended north east gable of Inchmore Cottage, north eastwards to a point 63 metres or thereby north east of the extended north east gable of Ivy Cottage, a distance of 2.584 kilometres or thereby.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the Order which, together with a plan showing the length of road involved and a statement of the Scottish Ministers' reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined free of charge during normal business hours from 29th November 2013 until 3rd January 2014 at the offices of Transport Scotland, Buchanan House, 58 Port Dundas Road, Glasgow, G4 0HF; BEAR Scotland, Bridge Point Depot, 23a Longman Drive, Inverness Depot, IV1 1SU and Glennoriston Stores, Invermoriston, Inverness, IV63 7YA.

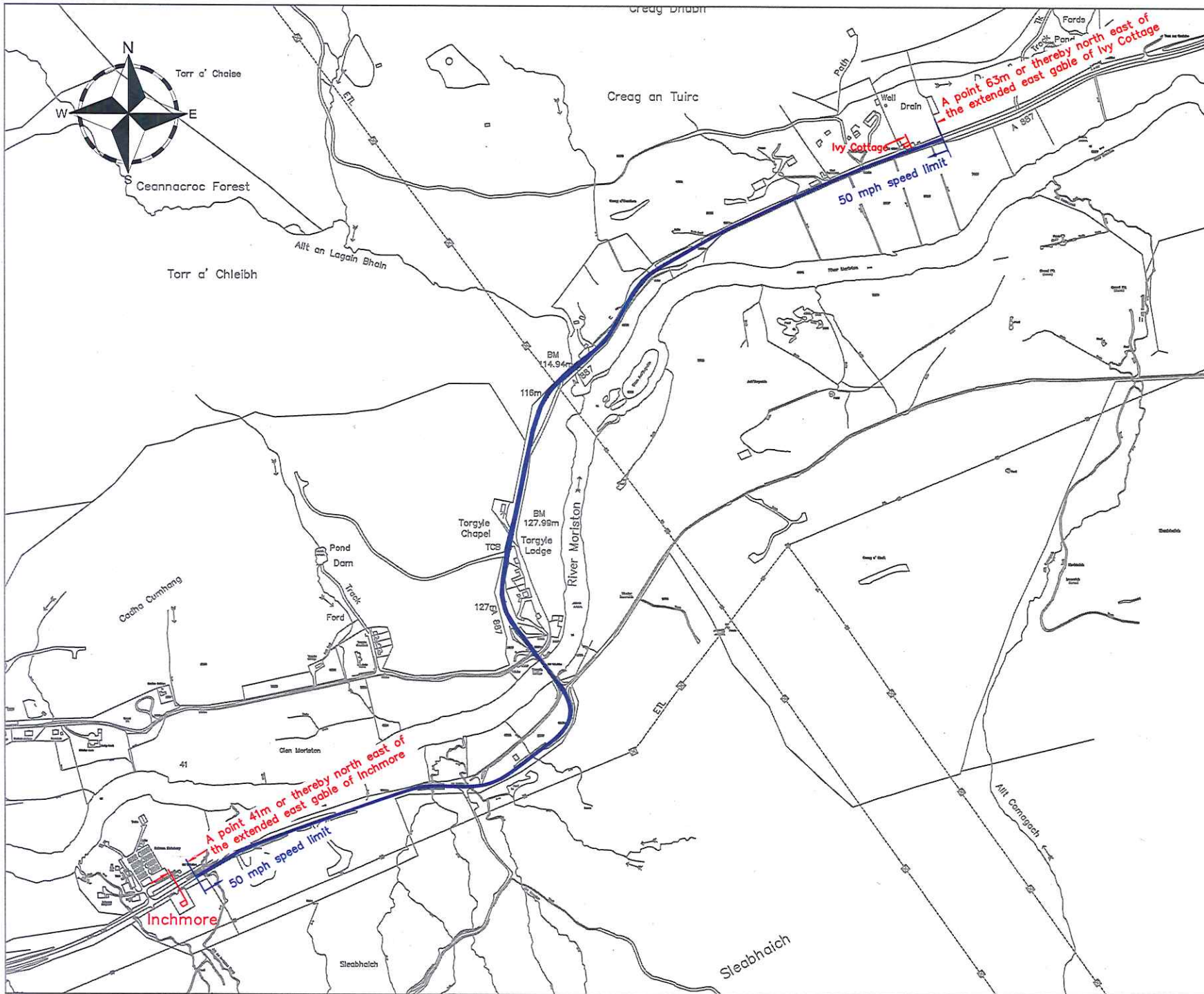

Statement of The Scottish Ministers' Reasons for Applying a
Maximum Speed Limit of 50mph on the Section of the A887
Invermoriston – Moriston Trunk Road at Torgoyle

Following completion of the Speed Limit Review, Scottish Ministers are satisfied that a 50 mph Speed Limit be imposed on the A887 Trunk Road at Torgoyle to improve road safety. The 50 mph speed limit will improve consistency with other routes and be appropriate for the environment in line with the function and nature of the road.
