The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1)(a), 2(1) and 2(2) and of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 1(1)(a) of that Act, they consider it expedient to do so for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the M9/A90/M90 Trunk Road (Netherley Junction to Cairnwell Junction, Portlethen) (Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 201[], comes into force on 201[]

Prohibition of specified turns

2. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order so as to make any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule.

3. No provision of this Order applies to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes.

PART 2

Prohibition of Right Turns

Prohibition of U-Turns

- 3. All u-turns from the southbound A90 Trunk Road at a location directly opposite the Junction to Cairnwell.
- **4.** All u-turns from the southbound A90 Trunk Road at a location directly opposite the property known as 'Bourtreebush Steading'.
- 5. All u-turns from the southbound A90 Trunk Road at a location directly opposite the property known as 'Bourtreebush Cottage'.
- **6.** All u-turns from the southbound A90 Trunk Road at a location directly opposite the Junction to Bruntland Road.
- 7. All u-turns from the southbound A90 Trunk Road at a location directly opposite the Junction to Netherley.
- **8.** All u-turns from the northbound A90 Trunk Road at a location directly opposite the Junction to Netherley.
- 9. All u-turns from the northbound A90 Trunk Road at a location directly opposite the Junction to Bruntland Road.
- 10. All u-turns from the northbound A90 Trunk Road at a location directly opposite the property known as 'Bourtreebush Cottage'.
- 11. All u-turns from the northbound A90 Trunk Road at a location directly opposite the property known as 'Bourtreebush Steading'.
- 12. All u-turns from the northbound A90 Trunk Road at a location directly opposite the Junction to Cairnwell.
