**The A9 Trunk Road (Inshes Junction) (30mph Speed Limit)
Order 2012**

Made - - - -

17th August 2012

Coming into force - -

27th August 2012

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 84(2)(b) of that Act they have given public notice of their intention to do so.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A9 Trunk Road (Inshes Junction) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2012 and comes into force on 27th August 2012.

Restriction of speed

2. No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c.27) (inserted by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (c.22), Schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by the S.I. 2001/1400) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54)). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by S.I. 1999/1750.

(b) Section 84(2) was substituted by the New Roads and Street works Act 1991 (c.22), section 168 Schedule 8 paragraph 61.

Exemption

3. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011^(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

That length of the M9/A9 Edinburgh - Stirling - Thurso Trunk Road being the Inshes Slip Road from a point 40 metres or thereby north west of the west gable of the property known as the Smithy, Inverness to a point 20 metres or thereby east of the intersection of the slip road with the A9 southbound carriageway, a distance of 145 metres or thereby.




