The A82 Trunk Road (Aonachan West, Spean Bridge) (Stopping Up) Order 2010

20th August 2010

Coming into force

30th August 2010

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 68(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 68(1) of that Act they consider that the road described in the Schedule to this Order has become unnecessary.

In accordance with section 68(2) of that Act they are satisfied that no alternative road is necessary.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Aonachan West, Spean Bridge) (Stopping Up) Order 2010 and comes into force on 30th August 2010.

Length of road to be stopped up

2. The Scottish Ministers, as roads authority, order that the length of road described in the Schedule shall be stopped up.

Statutory undertakers



The A82 Trunk Road (Aonachan Lay-by, Spean Bridge) (Stopping Up) Order 2006

Coming into force

23rd February 2006

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 68(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having considered that the road specified in the Schedule to this Order has become unnecessary and being satisfied that no alternative road is necessary, hereby making the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Aonachan Lay-by, Spean Bridge) (Stopping Up) Order 2006 and shall come into force on 23rd February 2006.
- 2. The stopping up of the road in the Highland Council area specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby ordered.
- 3. Where there is, immediately before the date on which the said road is stopped up under this Order, any apparatus belonging to any statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across that road for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the said statutory undertakers shall after the commencement of this Order continue to have all rights in respect of the said apparatus as they had immediately before that date.
