ROAD TRAFFIC

The A85 Trunk Road (Dalmally) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2008

*Made* 4<sup>th</sup> December 2008

*Coming into force* 15<sup>th</sup> December 2008

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) as read with section 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and all other powers enabling them in that behalf.

They have complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b).

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the A85 Trunk Road (Dalmally) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2008, comes into force on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2008.

**Restriction of speed**

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

## Article 2

That length of the A85 Tyndrum - Oban Trunk Road from a point 78 metres or thereby west of the extended centreline of Dalmally Village Loop Road (East) eastwards to a point 48 metres or thereby east of the extended centreline of Dalmally Primary Care Centre Access Road, a distance of 1.21 kilometres or thereby.

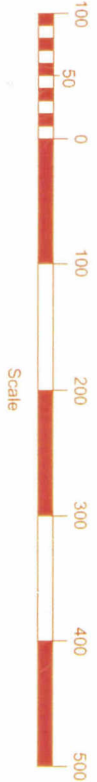
