**ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A85 Trunk Road (St Fillans) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2009

*Made* 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2009

*Coming into force* 13<sup>th</sup> March 2009

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

They have complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), before making this Order.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as The A85 Trunk Road (St Fillans) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2009 and comes into force on 13<sup>th</sup> March 2009.

**Restriction of speed**

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

That length of the A85 Perth – Lochearnhead Trunk Road at St Fillans from a point 70 metres or thereby northwest of the extended southeast gable of the property known as ‘The Kopje’ generally in a southeasterly direction to a point 17 metres or thereby southeast of the extended southeast gable of the property known as ‘Tarken’, a distance of 900 metres or thereby.
