ROAD TRAFFIC

The A87 Trunk Road (Portree) (40mph and 30mph Speed Limits) and Portree High School (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Variation and Revocation Order 2011

Made

11th March 2011

Coming into force

25th March 2011

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 82(2)(a), 83(1), 84(1)(a) and (c) and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

They have complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A87 Trunk Road (Portree) (40mph and 30mph Speed Limits) and Portree High School (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Variation and Revocation Order 2011 and comes into force on 25th March 2011.

Direction that a length of road ceases to be a restricted road

2. It is directed that the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order ceases to be a restricted road for the purposes of section 81 of the 1984 Act.

3. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

Restrictions of speed

(a) 1984 c.27; section 83(1) was amended by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (c.22) Schedule 8; section 84(1) was substituted by the Road Traffic Act 1991 (c.40), section 45(2). The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c.27) (inserted by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (c.22), Schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by the Scotland Act 1998 (Consequential Modifications) Order 2001 (S.I. 2001/1400)) as read with section 15(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by the Scotland Act 1998 (Transfer of Functions to the Scottish Ministers etc.) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/1750).

(b) S.I. 1987/2244.

(2) No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20mph on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order when such speed limit applies to that length of road in accordance with paragraph (3).

(3) A 20mph speed limit applies to the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order when such speed limit is indicated by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a).

(4) No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the length of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.

Revocation of previous Orders

4. (1) The Highland Regional Council (Portree, Skye) (Restricted Roads and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 1990 (Amendment) Order 1993 (b) is revoked.

(2) The A87 Trunk Road (Portree)(30mph and 40mph Speed Limits) and Portree High School (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2006(c) is revoked.

SCHEDULE 1

Length of Road to which 30 mph Speed Limit applies

That length of the A87 Invergarry – Kyle of Lochalsh – Borve - Uig Trunk Road from a point 12 metres or thereby south of the northern boundary wall of Portree Cemetery northwards, then north-westwards to a point 50 metres or thereby northwest of the centreline of Sluggans Road, a distance of 2.06 kilometres or thereby.

SCHEDULE 2

Length of Road to which 20 mph Part Time Speed Limit applies

That length of the A87 Invergarry – Kyle of Lochalsh – Borve – Uig Trunk Road in Portree from a point 40 metres or thereby south of the extended southern boundary of The Manse, Viewfield Road, Portree north-westwards then northwards to a point opposite the extended southeast gable of No 7 Viewfield Square, Portree, a distance of 420 metres or thereby.

SCHEDULE 3

Length of Road to which 40mph Speed Limit applies

That length of the A87 Invergarry – Kyle of Lochalsh – Borve - Uig Trunk Road from a point 50 metres or thereby northwest of the centreline of Sluggans Road north-westwards to a point 200 metres or thereby northwest of the centreline of Market Place, a distance of 514 metres or thereby.
