# **ROADS AND BRIDGES**

The A828 Trunk Road (Duror Village Cycle Track) (Redetermination of Means of Exercise of Public Right of Passage) Order 2013

Coming into force

28th January 2013

The Scottish Ministers have made the following order, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and 152(2) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984(a) and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

#### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A828 Trunk Road (Duror Village Cycle Track). (Redetermination of Means of Exercise of Public Right of Passage) Order 2013 and comes into force on 28th January 2013.

#### Redetermination of means of exercise of public right of passage

2. The length of road in Highland specified in the Schedule to this Order, at present footway, shall become cycle track, the right of passage being exercisable on pedal cycle and foot only.

That length of the existing footway on the north west side of the A828 Connel to South Ballachulish Trunk Road from a point 16 metres or thereby south east of the south eastern corner of Duror Primary School, in a generally south easterly then generally north easterly direction for a distance of 17 metres to a point 30 metres or thereby east south east of the south eastern corner of Duror Primary School, as shown by sawtooth hatching on plan RD031/001 entitled The A828 Trunk Road (Duror Village Cycle Track) (Redetermination of Means of Exercise of Public Right of Passage) Order 2013, signed with reference to this Order and deposited at the offices of Transport Scotland, Buchanan House, 58 Port Dundas Road, Glasgow G4 0HF.
