The A835/A893 Trunk Road (Garve) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2009

10th February 2009

Coming into force

19th February 2009

The Scottish Ministers make the following order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) and section 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them to do so. They have complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b) before making this Order.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A835/A893 Trunk Road (Garve) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 19th February 2009.

Restriction of speed

- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. This restriction shall apply only to the part or parts of the said length of road by means of traffic signs as prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(c).
