## ROAD TRAFFIC

The A68 Trunk Road (Dalkeith) (30 mph Speed Limit and St David's Primary School part-time 20 mph Speed Limit) Order 2008

Made Coming into force 7<sup>th</sup> November 2008 14<sup>th</sup> November 2008

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 82(2)(a), 83(1), 84(1)(a) and (c) and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

They have complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b).

#### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A68 Trunk Road (Dalkeith) (30 mph Speed Limit and St David's Primary School part-time 20 mph Speed Limit) Order 2008 and shall come into force on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2008.

## 30 mph Speed Limit

2. Subject to Article 3, no person shall drive any motor vehicle on the length of road specified in schedule 1 to this Order at a speed exceeding 30mph.

# Part-time 20 mph Speed Limit

- 3. (1) No person shall drive any motor vehicle on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order at a speed exceeding 20 mph when such speed limit applies to that length of road in accordance with paragraph (2).
- (2) A 20 mph speed limit applies to the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order when a 20 mph speed limit is indicated by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(c)


