Dear Neighbour,

Further to our flyer F82 issued on 16<sup>th</sup> November 2015 we are writing to confirm that the work described therein did not go ahead as planned and will now happen this coming Saturday night and we will also execute minor additional works next Monday night.

The work on the Saturday night involves the demolition of the wingwalls of the Northmost underpass of Ferrytoll roundabout as part of the works phasing required to complete the transfer of traffic to the final road alignment. The Monday night work will involve creating an access in the central reserve of the A90 near Ferrytoll roundabout.

The work will be performed outwith normal daytime working hours, during the night and, whilst we will endeavour to minimise noise levels in the process and execute the noisiest works as early in the shift as possible, we are concerned that our neighbours will find the activities disturbing.

During the Saturday works we will temporarily close the north leg of the Ferrytoll roundabout. Signed road diversions will be in place. The Monday works do not require a road diversion.

The descriptions, dates, times and details of plant for the night shifts are as follows:-

- Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2016 9pm through to Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2016 6am. Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2016 9pm through to Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> January 2016 6am. Plant will include a road brush, tracked excavators, hydraulic hammers, lorries and wheeled excavators.

We would like to take this opportunity to apologise for any inconvenience our activities may cause and also to thank you for your patience and consideration to date.

**The times indicated can be influenced by many factors and may change without warning near or during the time of execution. Also, the overall duration of each element may require to be extended in duration to achieve completion should unforeseen circumstances be encountered.**
