**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A77 Trunk Road (Cairnryan) (30 mph Speed Limit)  
Order 2012**

*Made* - - - -

*Coming into force* - - -

*30th April 2012*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84(1)(a) and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 84(2)(b) of that Act they have given public notice of their intention to do so.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the A77 Trunk Road (Cairnryan) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2012 and comes into force on 30th April 2012.

**Restriction of speed**

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

**Exemption**

3. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2001(c).

## SCHEDULE

### Article 2

That length of the M77/A77 Glasgow – Stranraer Trunk Road, from a point 777 metres or thereby south of the extended southern parapet line of Claddy House Bridge, in a northerly direction to a point 148 metres or thereby north of the northern channel line of the roundabout on the A77 at Belfast Way, Cairnryan, for a distance of 3,055 metres or thereby.
