The A77 Trunk Road (Girvan) (Restricted Roads) Order 2011

Made

15th March 2011

Coming into force

28th March 2011

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 82(2)(b), 83(1), and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

They have complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A77 Trunk Road (Girvan) (Restricted Roads) Order 2011 and comes into force on 28th March 2011.

Direction that a length of road shall become a restricted road

2. It is directed that the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of section 81 of the 1984 Act.

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c.27) (inserted by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (c.22), Schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by the Scotland Act 1998 (Consequential Modifications) Order 2001 (S.I. 2001/1400)) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by the Scotland Act 1998 (Transfer of Functions to the Scottish Ministers etc.) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/1750).

Variation of previous Order

3. (1) The Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads) (Ayrshire) Order 1975(**a**) is varied to the effect that paragraph 2b of the Schedule to that Order is revoked.

That length of the M77/A77 Glasgow – Stranraer Trunk Road at Girvan from a point 36 metres or thereby west of west tangent point of splitter island of Shallochpark Roundabout to a point 167.3 metres or thereby south of the junction with route B734, a distance of 2.45 kilometres or thereby.

THE SCOTTISH MINISTERS hereby give notice that they have made the above Order under sections 82(2)(b), 83(1) and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads)(Ayrshire) Order 1975

Made 30 April 1975

Coming into operation 11 May 1975

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 72(3), 73(1) (a) and (2) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a) as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1973(c), the Secretary of State hereby directs as follows:-

1. This order may be cited as the Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads)(Ayrshire) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 11 May 1975
2. The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this order and the order hereby revoked as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads)(Scotland) Order 1970(e) is hereby revoked.
4. At 11.59 pm on 11 May 1975 each of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this order shall cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of section 71(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended (which imposes a speed limit of 30 m.p.h. on a restricted road).
5. At 00.01 am on 12 May 1975 each of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of section 71(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended (which imposes a speed limit of 30 m.p.h. on a restricted road).

SCHEDULE

1. The Dumfries-Kilmarnock Trunk Road (Route A76) in the County of Ayr:-
 - a. at New Cumnock from a point at Afton Bridgend 137 yards or thereby east of Cairnhill Place to a point 70 yards or thereby west of Loch View, a distance of 2550 yards or thereby;
 - b. at Cumnock from a point 10 yards or thereby south of the south junction with John Allan Drive to a point 20 yards or thereby north-west of the access road to Holmhead Hospital, a distance of 2457 yards or thereby;
 - c. at Auchinleck from a point 357 yards or thereby south-east of the junction with Route B7036 to a point 20 yards or thereby north-west of the junction with Pennyland Road, a distance of 1657 yards or thereby;
 - d. at Mauchline from a point 30 yards or thereby south-east of the junction with Station Road to a point 220 yards or thereby south of the Millend-Auchmillan Road, a distance of 1620 yards or thereby.

2. The Stranraer-Glasgow Trunk Road (Route A77) in the County of Ayr:-

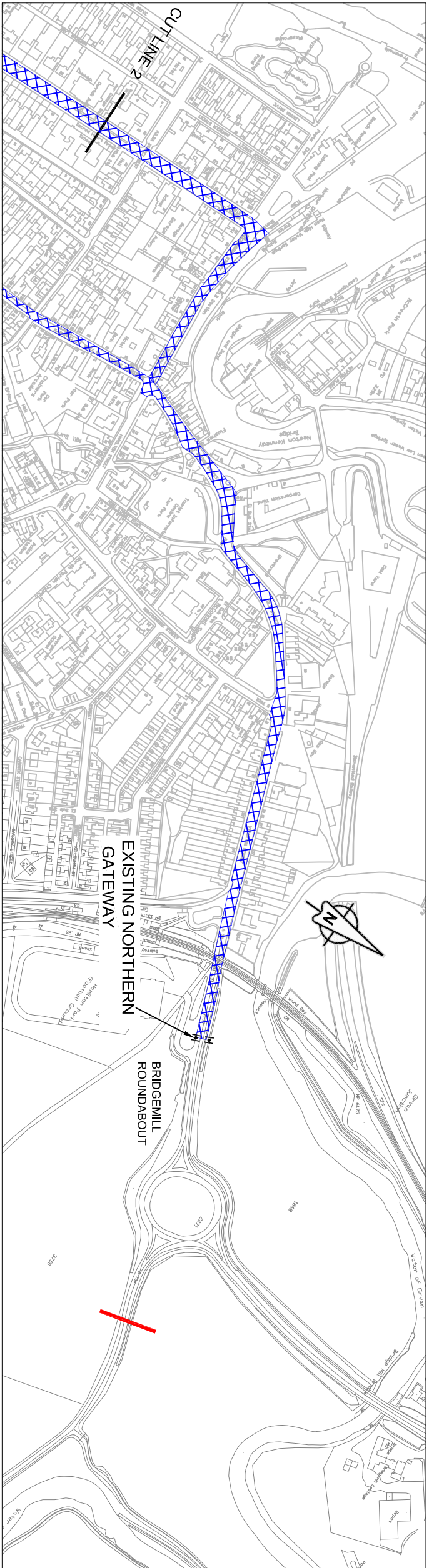
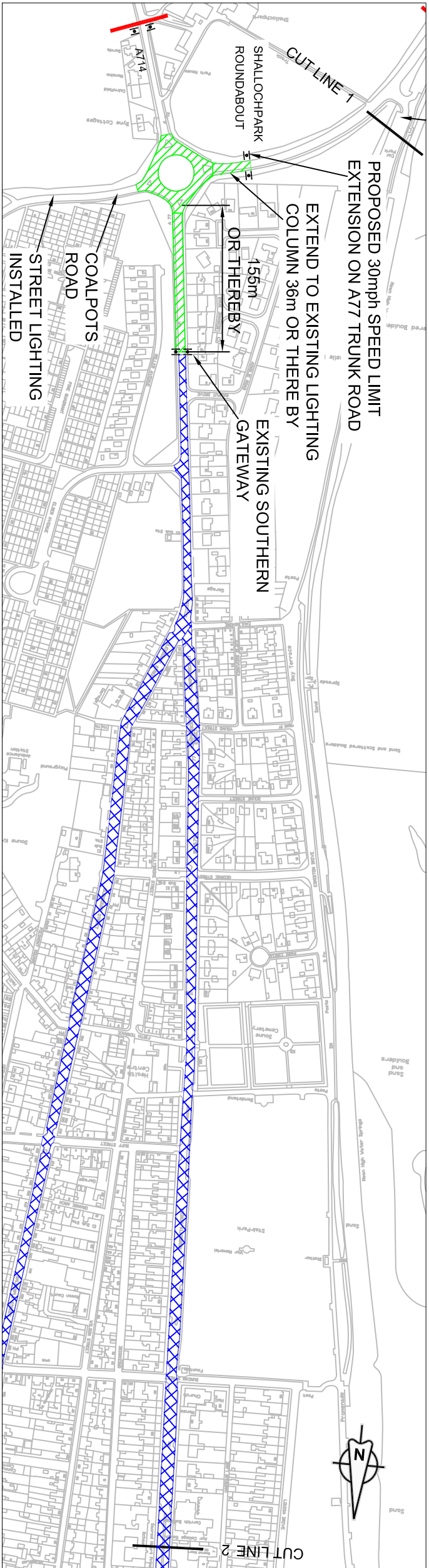
- a. at Ballantrae from a point at the southern end of the bridge parapet of Ballantrae Bridge to a point 520 yards or thereby north of the northern junction with Shellknowe, a distance of 1157 yards or thereby;
- b. at Girven from a point 210 yards or thereby south of the southern boundary of Doune Primary School to a point 183 yards or thereby south of the junction with Route B734, a distance of 2393 yards or thereby;
- c. at Kirkoswald from a point 100 yards or thereby south of the junction with Corrieston Road to a point 30 yards or thereby east of the junction with Balvaird Road, a distance of 690 yards or thereby;
- d. at Maybole from a point at the western boundary of Carrick Academy to a point 15 yards or thereby west of the access to Lyncaston Farm Steading, a distance of 2017 yards or thereby;
- e. at Minishant from a point 80 yards or thereby south-east of the junction with Mure Place to a point at the north-east end of the parapets of Minishant Bridge, a distance of 517 yards or thereby.

3. The Greenock-Monkton Trunk Road (Route A78) in the County of Ayr:-

- a. at Skelmorlie from the Ayr/Renfrew County Boundary to a point 10 yards or thereby south of the junction with Eglinton Terrace, a distance of 2400 yards or thereby;
- b. at Largs from a point 50 yards or thereby north of the southern boundary of Hollywood Convalescent Home to a point 643 yards or thereby south of the junction with Route A760, a distance of 3957 yards or thereby;
- c. at Fairlie from a point 37 yards or thereby south of the access road to Kilburn Avenue to its junction with the southern boundary of Montgomery Avenue, a distance of 1833 yards or thereby;
- d. at West Kilbride from a point 30 yards or thereby north of the junction with Corsehill Drive in a southerly direction for a distance of 1735 yards or thereby;
- e. at Ardrossan from a point 100 yards or thereby north-west of the centre-line of Burnfoot Bridge to the junction with Sorbie Road, Saltcoats, a distance of 1980 yards or thereby;
- f. at Stevenston from a point 30 yards or thereby west of the junction with Old High Road to a point 100 yards or thereby east of the western boundary of Hawkhill Cemetery, a distance of 1990 yards or thereby;
- g. at Loans from a point 40 yards or thereby north of the junction with Seaview Terrace to a point 43 yards or thereby south-east of the junction with Route A759, a distance of 567 yards or thereby.
