The A78 Trunk Road (Nelson Street/Newton Street) (Detrunking) Order 2011

Made

9th September 2011

Coming into force

19th September 2011

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 5(2) and (6) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 5(2) of that Act, they have taken into consideration the requirements of local and national planning, including the requirements of agriculture and industry and are satisfied as to expediency.

This Order is made in accordance with the provisions of Parts I and III of Schedule 1(b) to that Act.

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the A78 Trunk Road (Nelson Street/Newton Street) (Detrunking) Order 2011, and comes into force on 19th September 2011.



2. Road ceasing to be trunk road

On the date of coming into force of this Order the lengths of road described in the Schedule shall cease to be trunk road and Inverclyde Council(a) shall become the roads authority for those lengths of road and shall enter them in their list of public roads.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

INTERPRETATION

In this Schedule -

"the A78 Trunk Road" means the A78 Greenock – Prestwick Trunk Road; "the Plan" means the plan numbered A78/10/SW/0901/036/100 entitled "The A78 Trunk Road (Nelson Street/Newton Street) (Detrunking) Order 201[]", signed with reference to this Order and deposited at the offices of Transport Scotland, Buchanan House, 58 Port Dundas Road, Glasgow, G4 0HF.

LENGTHS OF ROAD CEASING TO BE TRUNK ROAD

- 1. That length of the A78 Trunk Road from a point whereby South Street roundabout Greenock meets Nelson Street, Greenock proceeding northeastwards for a distance 140 metres or thereby, as shown by black and white hatching between points A and B on the plan.
- 2. That length of A78 Trunk Road from the point where Newton Street, Greenock meets Nelson Street, Greenock proceeding southsoutheastwards for a distance of 110 metres or thereby, as shown by black and white hatching between points C and D on the plan.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Scottish Ministers have made the following Order under sections 5(2) and (6) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984:

The A78 Trunk Road (Nelson Street/Newton Street)(Detrunking) Order 2011 the general effect of which will be the detrunking of existing trunk road.

COPIES of the Order as made and the relevant plan may be inspected, free of charge, during normal business hours, until 21st October 2011 at the offices of Transport Scotland, Buchanan House, 58 Port Dundas Road, Glasgow, G4 0HF; the offices of Inverclyde Council, 24 Clyde Square, Greenock, Inverclyde PA15 1LY and Greenock Central Library, Clyde Square, Greenock, PA15 1NA.

ANY PERSON aggrieved by the Order who desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision therein on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 or that any requirement of the said Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks of the making of the Order make application to the Court of Session for the suspension of the operation of, or the quashing of, the Order or any provision contained therein.
