THE A96 TRUNK ROAD (INVERNESS TO NAIRN (INCLUDING NAIRN BYPASS)) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2024

The Scottish Ministers give notice that they have made the following Orders for the purpose of improving and constructing a new length of the A96 Aberdeen – Inverness Trunk Road between Seafield Roundabout, Inverness and Wester Hardmuir in the vicinity of Nairn, Nairnshire:

- 1. The A96 Trunk Road (Inverness to Nairn (including Nairn Bypass)) (Trunking & Detrunking) Order 2024 under sections 5(2) and (6) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 ("the Act") trunking and detrunking certain lengths of road; and
- 2. The A96 Trunk Road (Inverness to Nairn (including Nairn Bypass)) (Side Roads) Order 2024 under sections 12(1) and (5) and 70(1) of the Act, improving or stopping up certain lengths of road, constructing new lengths of road, stopping up certain private accesses and providing new private accesses.

The Orders will become operative on 12th March 2024.
