Cross border services should continue as those trains are used by many passengers north of Edinburgh, in my case, from Leuchars. This station is used by many students who travel to Leuchars from the south and are laden with luggage which makes changing trains difficult. I do not see any additional benefits from having an Edinburgh hub as Edinburgh already provides services to major cities. Visitors/passengers from the South can avail themselves of the western route trains if they wish to visit West coast/Western stations. St. Andrews is a sizeable community whose nearest station is Leuchars. To deprive passengers in this area of a cross border service will discourage them from using the rail service.
