ROAD TRAFFIC

The A85 Trunk Road (St. Fillans) (20mph and 30mph Speed Limits) Order 202[]

Coming into force - - []

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 82(2), 83(1) 84(1)(a) and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of Part IV of schedule 9 of, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with sections 83(1) and 84(2)(b) of that Act, they have given public notice of their intention to make the following Order, and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(c).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A85 Trunk Road (St. Fillans) (20mph and 30mph Speed Limits) Order 202[] and comes into force on [].

Speed limits

2. No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding—
- (a) 20 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Part 1 of the schedule,
 - (b) 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Part 2 of the schedule.

Revocation

3. The A85 Trunk Road (St. Fillans) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2001(d) is revoked.

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (c. 27) (inserted by the 1991 Act, schedule 8(II), paragraph 70 and amended by S.I. 2001/1400) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c. 54) (relevantly amended by S.I. 2001/1400). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c. 46).

4. Omit paragraph 51 of Part 1 of the schedule, at page 22, of the Tayside Region (Restricted Roads) Order 1988^(a).

Exemption

5. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to—

- (a) vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011^(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations; or
- (b) vehicles being used in an emergency for coastguard purposes.

SCHEDULE

SPECIFIED LENGTHS OF ROAD

Article 2

PART 1

1. That length of the A85 Perth – Lochearnhead Trunk Road at St. Fillans, from a point 20 metres or thereby east of the extended centreline of its junction with Station Road to a point 112 metres or thereby west of the extended centreline of its junction with Manse Lane, a distance of 800 metres or thereby.

PART 2

2. That length of the A85 Perth – Lochearnhead Trunk Road at St. Fillans, from a point 75 metres or thereby east of the extended centreline of its junction with South Lochearn Road to a point 20 metres or thereby east of the extended centreline of its junction with Station Road, a distance of 306 metres or thereby.

3. That length of the A85 Perth – Lochearnhead Trunk Road at St. Fillans, from a point 112 metres or thereby west of the extended centreline of its junction with Manse Lane to a point 833 metres or thereby west of the extended centreline of its junction with Manse Lane, a distance of 721 metres or thereby.
