ROADS AND BRIDGES

The A95 Trunk Road (Lackghie Improvement) (Side Roads) Order 2010

Made 22nd January 2010

Coming into force 29th January 2010

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 12(1) and (5) and 70(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 12(3) of that Act, they are satisfied that another reasonably convenient route will be provided before any road is stopped up pursuant to this Order.

In accordance with section 71(3) of that Act, they are satisfied, as the case requires, that another reasonably convenient means of access to the land is available or will be provided.

In accordance with sections 20A(b) and 55A(c) of that Act, they have determined that the project falls within Annex II to Council Directive 85/337/EEC(d) on the assessment of the effects of certain public and private projects on the environment but having regard to the selection criteria contained in Annex III it should not be made subject to an environmental impact assessment in accordance with the Directive.

They have complied with the requirements of Part 1 of Schedule 1(e) to that Act.

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the A95 Trunk Road (Lackghie Improvement) (Side Roads) Order 2010 and comes into force on 29th January 2010.

(2) In this Order:-

“plan SR1” means the plan entitled “The A95 Trunk Road (Lackghie Improvement) (Side Roads) Order 2010 Plan SR1”, signed with reference to this Order and deposited at the offices of Transport Scotland, Buchanan House, 58 Port Dundas Road, Glasgow, G4 0HF.


Side roads and means of access

2. The Scottish Ministers as roads authority are authorised –

- (a) to stop-up each private means of access described in column 1 of Schedule 1 when the new means of access described in the corresponding entry in column 2 of that Schedule has been provided;
- (b) to provide those new means of access described in column 2 of Schedule 1;
- (c) to provide those new means of access described in Schedule 2;
- (d) to improve those lengths of private means of access as described in Schedule 3;
- (e) to stop-up that length of private means of access as described in Schedule 4; and
- (f) to stop-up those lengths of Trunk Road as described in Schedule 5 with effect from the date when the length of road described in the Schedule to the A95 Trunk Road (Lackghie Improvement) Order 2010 is open for the purpose of through traffic.

Statutory Undertakers

3. Where immediately before the date this Order comes into force there is under, in, on, over, along or across any of the lengths of road described in Schedule 5 to this Order any apparatus of a statutory undertaker, any rights of the statutory undertaker in respect of such apparatus shall be preserved.



ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984

THE A95 TRUNK ROAD (LACKGHIE IMPROVEMENT)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Scottish Ministers have made the following Orders:

1. The A95 Trunk Road (Lackghie Improvement) Trunk Road Order 2010 under section 5(2) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, the general effect of which will be to provide for the construction of new Trunk Road at Lackghie, Boat of Garten, Inverness-shire.
2. The A95 Trunk Road (Lackghie Improvement) (Side Roads) Order 2010 under sections 12(1) and (5) and 70(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, the general effect of which will be to provide for the construction of new private means of access to the new trunk road; the stopping up of various existing roads; the stopping up of various private means of access; and the provision and improvement of certain new private means of access.





