

PRESS NOTICE

THE M876/A876 TRUNK ROAD (KINCARDINE BRIDGE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF SPECIFIED TURNS) ORDER 2017

THE SCOTTISH MINISTERS give notice that they have made the above Order under sections 2(1) and 2, 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, temporarily prohibiting traffic on that length of the M876/A876 Dennyloanhead – Kilbagie Roundabout Trunk Road from a point 390 metres or thereby south of its junction with the A977 Longannet Roundabout – Gartarry Roundabout Trunk Road, in a southwards direction to its junction with the A985 Kincardine – Rosyth Trunk Road, a distance of 14 metres or thereby from making the following turns:

1. All right turns from the southbound carriageway of the M876/A876 Dennyloanhead – Kilbagie Roundabout Trunk Road onto the westbound carriageway of the A985 Kincardine – Rosyth Trunk Road.

The Order, which is required to facilitate maintenance works on Kincardine Bridge, will be in operation from 21 July until 31 August 2017, and will only have effect in relation to such part or parts of the length of road as is indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.

The Order does not apply to vehicles while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes or vehicles being used to carry out the works.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES

The alternative routes for traffic during the prohibition will be signposted. Detailed description can also be obtained at Amey, 6a Dryden Road, Bilston Glen Industrial Estate, Loanhead, Edinburgh, EH20 9LZ.

ROAD TRAFFIC

The M876/A876 Trunk Road (Kincardine Bridge) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2017

Made - - - - *12th July 2017*

Coming into force - - *21st July 2017*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the schedule should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the M876/A876 Trunk Road (Kincardine Bridge) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2017, comes into force on 21st July 2017 and ceases to have effect on 31st August 2017.

Prohibition of specified turns

2. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the schedule of this Order so as to make any turn specified in Part 2 of the schedule when a prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road by means of an appropriate traffic sign of the type described in item 7 (diagram 612 – no right turn for vehicular traffic) of the sign table in Part 2 of schedule 3 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(b).

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (inserted by the 1991 Act, schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by S.I. 2001/1400) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54) (relevantly amended by S.I. 2001/1400). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Exemptions

3. No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to—

- (a) a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes; or
- (b) a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

PART 1

SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the M876/A876 Dennyloanhead – Kilbagie Roundabout Trunk Road from a point 390 metres or thereby south of its junction with the A977 Longannet Roundabout – Gartarry Roundabout Trunk Road in a southwards direction to its junction with the A985 Kincardine – Rosyth Trunk Road, a distance of 14 metres or thereby.

PART 2

SPECIFIED TURNS

All right turns from the southbound carriageway of the M876/A876 Dennyloanhead – Kilbagie Roundabout Trunk Road onto the westbound carriageway of the A985 Kincardine – Rosyth Trunk Road.
