The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 84(1) and 84(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Edinburgh-Thurso Trunk Road (A882) (Thurso) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 1992 and shall come into force on 21st September 1992.
- 2. No person shall drive or cause to be driven any vehicle at a speed exceeding $40 \mathrm{mph}$ on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Schedule

That length of the Edinburgh-Thurso Trunk Road (A882) at Thurso from its junction with the A836 at the Way Inn Motel in an easterly direction for a distance of 190 metres or thereby.
