**THE A9 TRUNK ROAD (KILLIECRANKIE TO GLEN GARRY)
(EXTINGUISHMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY) ORDER 201[]**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 3 of the Acquisition of Land (Authorisation Procedure) (Scotland) Act 1947 propose to make the above-mentioned Order extinguishing certain public rights of way in the County of Perth and providing alternative public rights of way, as described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY TO BE EXTINGUISHED

1. A length of the existing public right of way, not being a vehicular right of way, which crosses the existing M9/A9 Trunk Road, in a generally northerly direction, leading to the footbridge over the River Garry, south of Blair Atholl, Perthshire.
2. A length of the existing public right of way, not being a vehicular right of way, leading from the Allt Bhaic burn, in a generally northerly direction, to verge of the existing M9/A9 Trunk Road, Perthshire.
3. A length of the existing public right of way, heading in a generally northerly direction from the unnamed track to the east of Struan Hall and across the existing M9/A9 Trunk Road, Perthshire.

PART 2

ALTERNATIVE RIGHT OF WAY TO BE PROVIDED

1. A public right of way crossing under the M9/A9 Trunk Road, in a generally westerly then northerly then south-easterly direction, to join where the existing right of way is to be stopped up, before the footbridge over the River Garry, south of Blair Atholl, Perthshire.
2. A public right of way following the line of the Allt Bhaic burn, from where the existing right is being stopped up, in a generally north-easterly direction, under the M9/A9 Trunk Road, then in a generally west, north-westerly direction, parallel to the M9/A9 Trunk Road, Perthshire.
3. A public right of way, not being a vehicular right of way, heading in a generally northerly direction away from the B847 Struan Hill Road, to the east of Struan Hall, under the M9/A9 Trunk Road, then in a generally easterly direction, to join where the existing right of way is stopped up, Perthshire.
