In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1(1), (2) and (3) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a) as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1973(c) the Secretary of State hereby makes the following order:-

- 1. This order may be cited as the Trunk Roads (Langholm) (Restriction of Waiting and Loading) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1974.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this order and the order hereby revoked as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The Trunk Roads (High Street and Market Place, Langholm) (Restriction of Waiting and Loading) (Consolidation) (No 2) Order 1973(e) is hereby revoked.
- 4. Save as provided in article 9, of this order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule to this order.
- 5. Save as provided in articles 9, 10 and 11 of this order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this order.
- 6. Save as provided in articles 9, 10 and 11 of this order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9 am and 6 pm on the length of road specified in Schedule 3 to this order.

- 7. Save as provided in articles 9, 10 and 11 of this order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9 am and 6 pm Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 to this order.
- 8. Save as provided in articles 9, 10 and 11 of this order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9 am and 6 pm Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, on any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 5 to this order
 - i. for a period longer than 30 minutes; or
 - ii. if a period of less than 30 minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on that length of road.
- 9. Nothing in articles 4, 5, 6, 7 or 8 of this order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait on any of the lengths of road referred to in those articles for so long as may be necessary:
 - a. to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle; or
 - b. to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878(a).
- 10. Nothing in articles 5, 6, 7 or 8 of this order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait on any of the lengths of road referred to in those articles for so long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle: provided that no vehicle shall so wait between the hours of 9 am and 6 pm, Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the length of road specified in article 5 of this order.
- 11. Nothing in articles 5, 6, 7 or 8 of this order shall apply to any disabled person's vehicle which is not causing an obstruction and which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge issued by a local authority in exercise of its powers under Section 21(1) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970(b): provided that no vehicle shall so wait between the hours of 9 am and 6 pm Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the length of road specified in article 5 of this order.

 - d) To enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties.

Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall apply to any disabled persons vehicle which is not causing an obstruction and which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge issued by the Local Authority in exercise of its powers under Section 21(1) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the (Edinburgh Carlisle Trunk Road A7/U715A John Street, Langholm)(Waiting, Loading, Unloading Restrictions) Traffic Regulation Order 1989 and shall commence on 24 November 1989.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1984 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 5(c) and (d) of this Order no person except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait, load or unload at any time on the lengths of road specified in Schedule One to this Order.

 - c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of roads so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of road, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph 10 of Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984.
 - d) To enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties.
- 6.
