**The A83 Trunk Road (Tarbert) (30mph Speed Limit) Order
201[]**

Coming into force - -

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84(1)(a), and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of schedule 9 of, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 84(2)(b) of that Act, they have given public notice of their intention to make the following Order, and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(c).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A83 Trunk Road (Tarbert) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 201[] and comes into force on [].

Speed restriction

2. No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the schedule.

Revocation

3. The A83 Trunk Road (Tarbert) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2007(d) is revoked.

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Exemption

4. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to—

- (a) vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011^(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations, or
- (b) vehicles being used in an emergency for coastguard purposes.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A83 Tarbet – Lochgilphead – Campbeltown Trunk Road at Tarbert from a point 60 metres or thereby northeast of the centreline of the access road to The Ridge in a generally south westerly direction to a point 60 metres or thereby southwest of the centreline of Glen Park, a distance of 1.44 kilometres or thereby.
